#### **Sacrament Information**

**Infant Baptism:** A preparation program for parents and godparents is required. Once paperwork is submitted, we will register you for preparation and schedule the date for Baptism.

**First Reconciliation & First Eucharist:** Customarily the reception of these sacraments takes place during 2nd grade. The child will need to have completed one year of religious education the year immediately prior to sacramental preparation and will continue in religious education concurrent with the preparation classes.

**Confirmation:** Candidates must be in the 9th grade or above to be confirmed. The candidate will need to have completed one year of youth group the year immediately prior to Confirmation preparation. They will also need to attend youth group the year of preparation. Preparation for adult Confirmation takes place in April. Confirmation will take place in May.

**Marriage:** Please call the Parish Office at least six months in advance to begin the preparation process. You will set the date for the wedding at the first meeting.

**Anointing of the Sick:** Please contact the parish office to arrange visitation and sacraments. You may leave a message any time of day or night and someone will get back to you as soon as possible.

Dear Parishioners,

When I look back at my childhood and teenage years, the times I feel that I was the most loved were the times my parents told me, "No." Granted, when I was in my teenage years the times my parents told me, "No!" were the times I questioned my parents love for me the most. Looking back on those times, however, there is no mistaking it: No really meant, "We love you."

Saying "No!" is difficult in a few ways. First, it goes against our natural desire to make our children happy. To say, "No!" often means that you are depriving them of something that they want and that can be difficult, even if we know that what they want will not make them happy in the long run. To say, "No" in these situations is actually a "Yes" to something better. It means that we are raising their minds to something greater than they desire.

But I think the most difficult aspect of saying no is that it requires a lot of energy. Saying "No!" means you are going to have a fight on your hands. You who are parents will understand what I mean. Saying no to a child means it's about to get very loud. I don't know of a single instance when a child threw a tantrum because their parents said, "Yes." It would be so easy to skip the drama altogether by giving in and saying, "Yes." This is why saying "No" is such a loving thing to do. It takes a lot of work.

The same goes with teenagers. Yes, some teenagers still throw tantrums as if they were three years old, but teenagers can also be much crueler to their parents when the answer is, "No." Teenagers will openly express their doubt that their parents really care about them at all and will even tell their parents they are hated. As an acquaintance of mine said, "Sometimes you need to love your children enough to let them hate you." Truer words have never been spoken.

So, beginning with my parents, I want to thank all the Moms and Dads out there who have loved their children enough to say, "No." Thanks for putting up with all our tantrums and putting up with our manipulative teenage drama. And to all the children and teenagers out there who are hopefully reading this who have heard, "No!" from your parents, I want you to know that you are very lucky that your parents love you enough to say that.

Whether you wanted them to buy you something that you weren't ready for, or whether it was when you wanted to do something with your friends that wasn't safe, or whether they didn't even have a reason, the word "No!" means your parents love you a lot. You should thank them for saying it.

As a Priest, I've also struggled to say no to people. This was not over moral issues, mind you. It was mostly over people wanting special treatment. I've said yes to things I shouldn't have because I didn't have the energy to have a conflict. Saying "Yes" when I shouldn't have has caused a lot of extra work for me and our staff as well as some occasional confusion among the people in our parish. It was not loving for me to say "Yes" in these situations.

So, as we enter into a new year of ministry, I'm preparing myself to say "No." I hope that if I ever have to say it to you or somebody you know that you'll know it is coming from a place of love. I'm trying to raise your minds to focus on something greater, or to help you develop other areas of your spiritual life. I'm saying it out of a desire for you and all of our parishioners to reach your full potential as disciples of the Lord and to maintain unity in our parishes.

#### **Qualified Charitable Distributions**

The 2017 Tax Act created higher standard deduction amounts, making it more difficult for taxpayers to itemize deductions, which include charitable deductions. Since many taxpayers will continue making charitable gifts that may not provide them with any financial benefit, it's important to rethink charitable gifts.

#### **Hypothetical:**

- Individual has a \$10,000 required minimum distribution (RMD)
- Individual directs the IRA Custodian to distribute any amount of the RMD directly to their charity of choice
- Any amount distributed to a qualified charity counts toward RMD requirement
- Any amount distributed to a qualified charity is not included in taxable income
- Individual benefits by not paying income tax on the distribution, while also fully benefitting from the higher standard deduction amount

#### **Rules:**

- Individual must have reached RMD age (70.5)
- Individual may make qualified charitable distributions in excess of their RMD amount, up to \$100,000/year.



#### TIEMPO ORDINARIO

Estamos en la **segunda semana** del **tiempo ordinario**. Estamos viendo la **LITURGIA DE LA PALABRA Salmo Responsorial** 



El <u>leccionario</u> es el libro empleado en las celebraciones litúrgicas para proclamar textos de la Sagrada Escritura.

Nuestra madre la Iglesia ha querido que nosotros sus hijos nos nutramos de la palabra de Dios, de modo que no nos falte el sustento necesario para nuestra vida. Muchos han leído la Biblia por su propia cuenta, y eso es muy bueno y provechoso, pero recordemos que el lugar privilegiado para escuchar la palabra de Dios son los sacramentos, en especial la Eucaristía. Recordemos que la palabra de Dios al igual que la

Eucaristía es alimento; por eso en la liturgia conocemos que en la celebración de la santa Misa se asiste a dos mesas, la mesa de la Palabra y la mesa de la eucaristía. La Iglesia ha clasificado las lecturas bíblicas en tres ciclos: A, B, y C. para los Domingos. Por lo tanto, si una persona participa atentamente en la misa dominical durante tres años habrá escuchado en su mayor parte la Sagrada Escritura.



En la liturgia de La Palabra después de la primera lectura se canta o recita un fragmento de un <u>salmo</u> tomado del libro homónimo, en forma *antifonal*: los fieles repiten una <u>antífona</u> y un salmista, lector, u otra persona idónea lee o canta los versículos del salmo. Esta parte de la Eucaristía goza de una gran importancia litúr-

gica y pastoral, ya que favorece la meditación de la palabra de Dios. El salmo responsorial ha de responder a cada lectura y ha de tomarse, por lo general, del Leccionario. Se ha de procurar que se cante el salmo responsorial ínte-

gramente, o, al menos, la respuesta que corresponde al pueblo. El salmista o cantor del salmo proclama sus estrofas desde el ambón o desde otro sitio oportuno, mientras toda la asamblea escucha sentada y participa además con su respuesta.




